BY-LAWS TO THE OIL CONSTITUTION

- I. Parliamentary procedures in OIL meetings, not covered by the OIL Constitution, shall be governed by the Newly Revised Robert's Rules of Order.
- II. The delegation Chairperson shall appoint a member of the delegation to serve as Parliamentarian and to advise the Chairperson on procedural questions at OIL meetings.
- III. The delegation Chair shall appoint a member of the delegation to serve as Sergeant-At-Arms to maintain order during OIL meetings.
- IV. There shall be a minimum of three (3) weekly meetings before each OIL state session. At the discretion of the Chairperson special meetings may be called.
